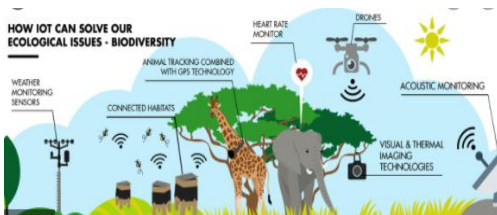

The process from Project Outline to end of the Project

If it is the first submission with Eurogia you have to present only the PO, Project Outline

- 1st Step: submission of a **Project Outline (PO)**

Evaluation of the PO by the Eurogia Technical Committee + recommendation from Public Authorities

- 2nd Step: Submission of a **Full Project Proposal (FPP)** in the following CALL

Evaluation of the PO by the Eurogia Technical Committee + recommendation from Public Authorities (+ Chances for funding)

- Granting of the Eurogia2030 LABEL
- National Application to the Funding Bodies

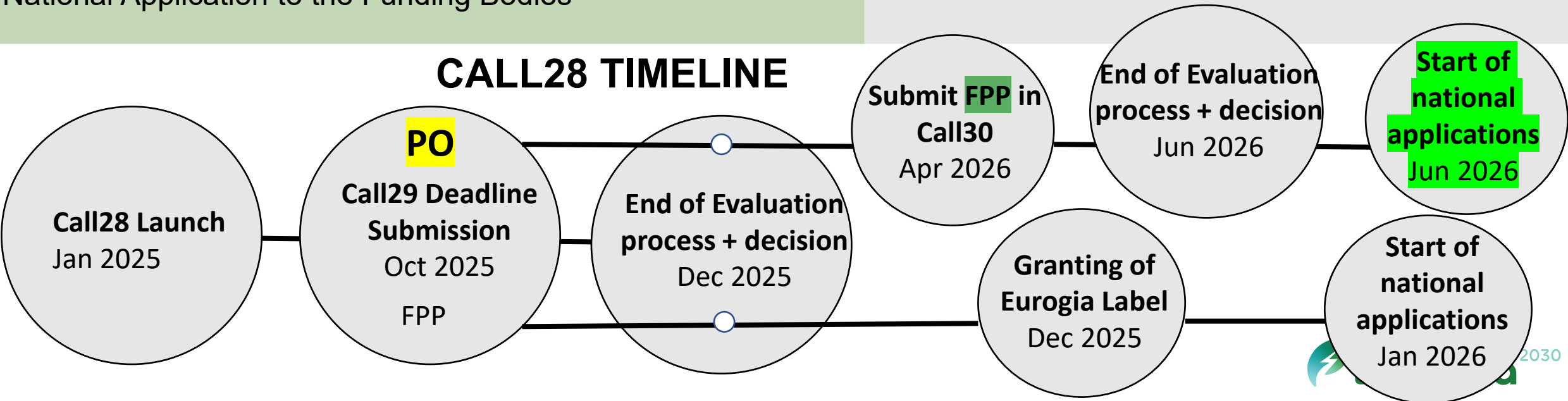


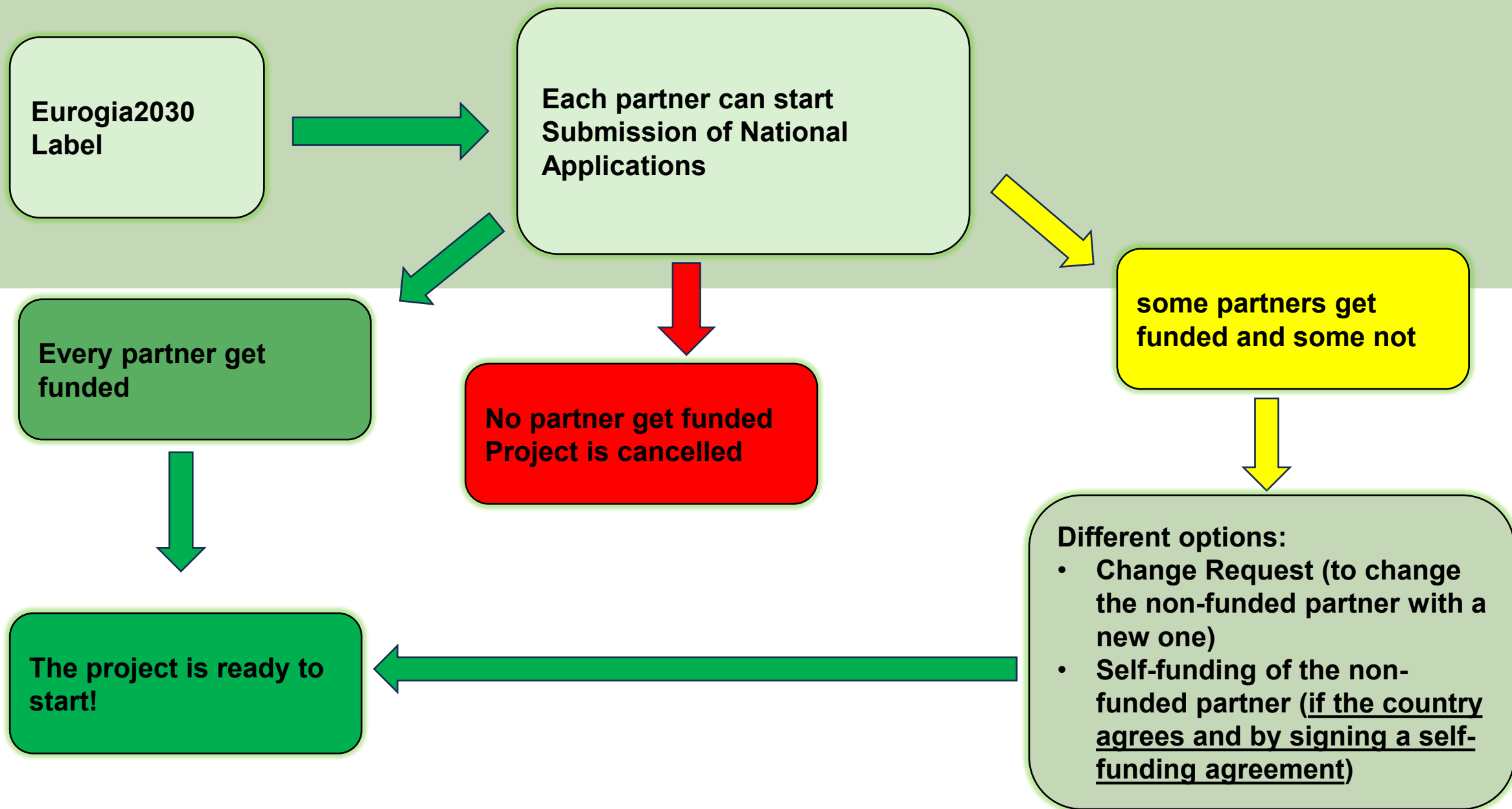

Final steps

Once the project is ready to start



The project Coordinator immediately communicate to the Eurogia office:

- Kick-off date
- Project Consortium Agreement
- Detailed Funded budgets (to be verified with the PAs)

Once the project is started



- Project fees are invoiced (1,5% of the funded budget. Only for industrial partners; Universities and Research Institutes are exempted)
- The coordinator send to the Eurogia office periodic reports (every year and one final report at the end of the project)



1. ...should primarily target Low Carbon Technologies beyond the State-of-the-Art

2. ...should propose innovations that will enable Energy applications

3. ...will form innovative ecosystems, producing high impact commercial and societal opportunities

4....will bring together international partners in the field of Low Carbon Technologies solutions

5. ...should have a balanced consortium of partners, each contributing significantly in the project

6. ...will be a “Mid-size” project with eligible costs in the range of €2-10m. (Bigger or smaller project can be eligible too)

7. ...should present results in a short term. Duration of the project should be around 2-4 years.

8....should have hold in-depth meetings with the Public Authorities in the countries from which they wish to gain support.



The Eurogia2030 Website

Project submissions will be based on the two steps process (1st step PO/ 2nd step FPP) accessed through the Eurogia Call Info website: <https://eurogia.eu/>

Call guidance is available on the website

Call submission support will be provided by the Eurogia cluster

It is essential for each partner to contact their supporting Public Authority at the earliest opportunity to verify eligibility

Funding rates/Rules of participation are subject to National policy

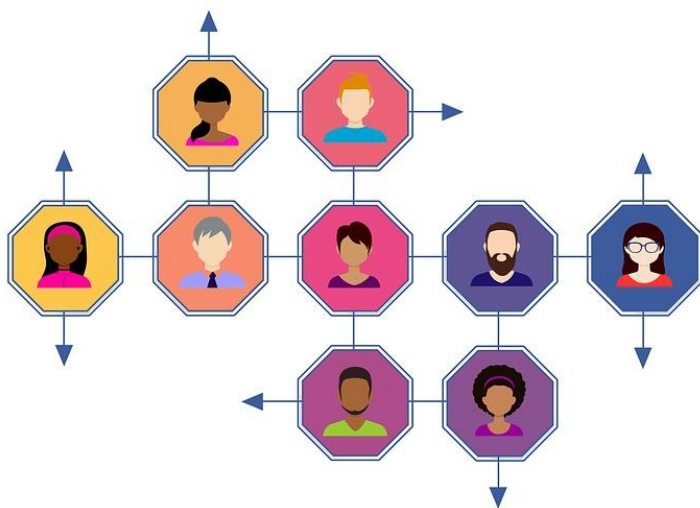
