







Evaluation of the PO by the Eurogia Technical Committee + recommendation from Public Authorities (+ Chances for funding)




Final steps

Once the project is ready to start

The project Coordinator immediately communicate to the Eurogia office:

- Kick-off date
- Project Consortium Agreement
- Detailed Funded budgets (to be verified with the PAs)

Once the project is started



- Project fees are invoiced (1,5% of the funded budget. Only for industrial partners; Universities and Research Institutes are exempted)
- The coordinator send to the Eurogia office periodic reports (every year and one final report at the end of the project)



8....should have hold in-depth meetings with the Public Authorities in the countries from which they wish to gain support.

1. ...should primarily target Low Carbon **Technologies beyond** the State-of-the-Art


